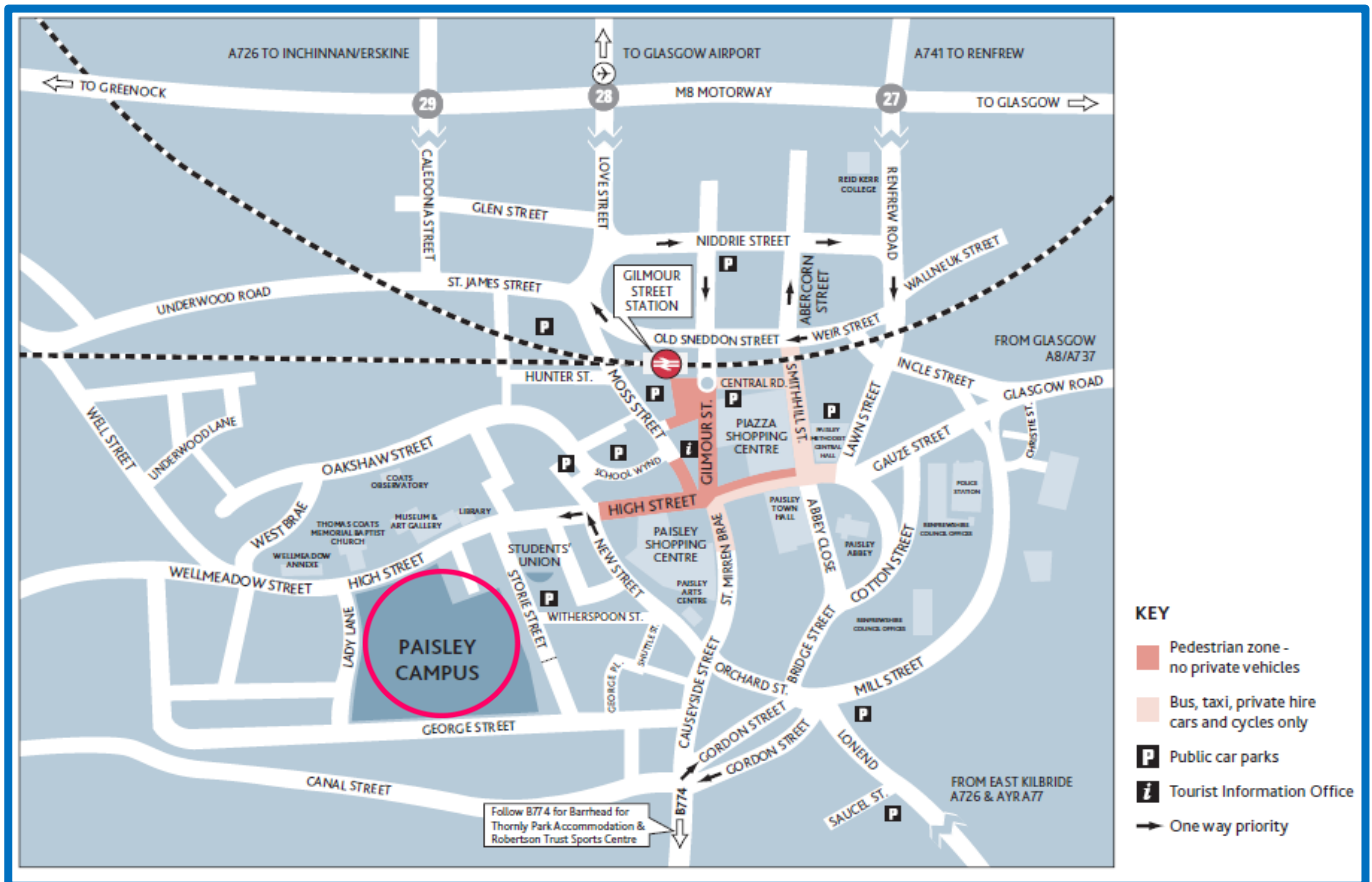

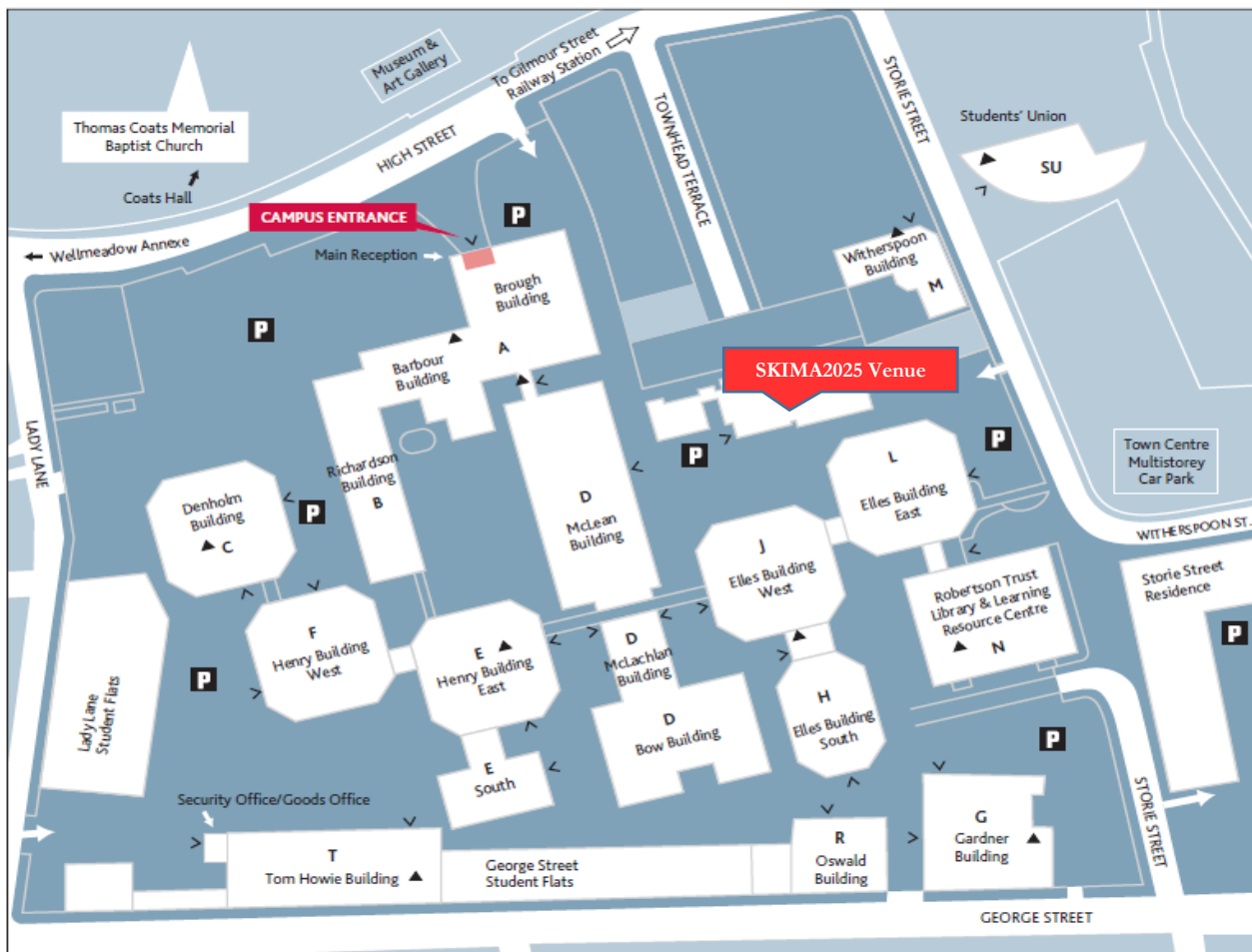

## **How to get from Glasgow Airport (GLA) and Edinburgh Airport (EDI) to Paisley?**

The distance between Glasgow Airport (GLA) and Paisley is 2 miles. It takes 10 minutes from Glasgow Airport (GLA) to Paisley by taxi or Uber. The cost is around £15.

McGills Bus Service operates a bus from Glasgow Airport (GLA) to Paisley hourly. Tickets cost around £5 and the journey takes 17 min.

If you are travelling via Edinburgh Airport (EDI), it is 50 miles away from Paisley. The cheapest way to get to Paisley costs around £15-£20 via bus, and the quickest way takes around one hour. We recommend taking the bus from Edinburgh Airport, Terminal Building to Buchanan Bus Station and then taking the bus from Buchanan Bus Station to Paisley, which takes around 1h 40m.

If you are staying in Glasgow city centre, you can use Train service to travel to Paisley. The average journey time between Glasgow Central station and Paisley Gilmour Street station is 14 minutes and two-way ticket costs around £7. On an average weekday, there are trains available in every 10 to 15 minutes from Glasgow Central to Paisley Gilmour Street. It takes about 10 min walk from the Paisley Gilmour Street station to the conference venue – Please follow the provided map.

McGills Bus Service (17 and 38) and First Bus service (9) operates regular bus services to Paisley from Glasgow city centre and tickets cost around £5. It takes about 5 min walk from the nearest bus stop to the conference venue.

The Main Reception of the University is located at the Brough Building 'A' (Campus Entrance near to High Street), the receptionists or the conference volunteers will guide the conference participants to the conference venue. You can also just follow the campus map.

Tea/Coffee will be available during the coffee breaks, and Buffet Lunch will be provided during the lunch times. Please check the conference schedule.

## HOTELS

Paisley is a small town and there are a few hotels in Paisley town centre. There are many hotels near Glasgow airport which is just 10 min away by Taxi/bus. If you prefer more vibrant city experience, there are many hotels near Glasgow Central Station in Glasgow city centre, which is 15-20 min away by train.

## CURRENCY AND EXCHANGE

The official currency of Scotland is the pound sterling (£) (English notes or Scottish notes).

You can exchange currency in Paisley with the Post office or use other available different options. (<https://www.compareholidaymoney.com/click-and-collect/location/glasgow.php>)

*(Note: Scottish bank notes are not afforded official legal tender status in England and Wales, but can legally be used within the UK. Normally, the Scottish notes are not accepted outside the UK).*

## WII-FI ACCESS

Wi-Fi Access will be available in all meeting venues.

Participants who have Eduroam login can connect to our network. Select Eduroam from the list of available WiFi networks then log in with the same ID and password you use at your own institution.

Other participants who do not have an Eduroam login can access Wi-fi through 'Guest' network. The 'Guest' network will be available to select from the list of WiFi networks. To access the 'Guest' network you will need to register your email and set a password on the login portal (link under the login ID and password fields)

## ELECTRICITY

In Scotland the power plugs and sockets are of type G. The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

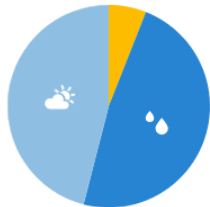


## WEATHER
